FORUM REGULATION

I. Forum Theme: To deepen Taiji wellness research and serve public health needs.

II. Eligible Topics:

- 1. Taiji science forum topics
 - 1) The historical origin, inheritance, and development of Taiji.
 - 2) Measurement indices and quantitative standards of Taiji.
 - 3) International exchanges and scientific research of Taiji.
 - 4) Industrial development, promotion, and dissemination of Taiji.
- 2. Taiji, Health qigong, Meditation, Sports Health, and wellness-preserving research on:
 - 1) Cognitive ability.
 - 2) Pain management.
 - 3) Balance and coordination.
 - 4) The immune system.
 - 5) Depression.
- 3. World Taiji Intangible Cultural Heritage Masters Exhibition (Video or PPT)
 - 1) Representatives of the main inheritors of the relevant styles of the Taijiquan Intangible Heritage List.
 - 2) Representatives of other Taijiquan, Health qigong, and other health-preserving methods.

III. Forum registration requirements

- 1. Submission requirements for Research Papers:
 - 1) The number of words in the abstract of the paper is limited between 500-1000 words. Number of words in the author's bio is limited to 300 words, and attached at the end of the article; If the author is selected as a speaker for the forum, the author will be asked to provide an additional PPT file.
 - 2) If the paper has multiple authors, please indicate the first author with superscript.
- 2. Requirements for Forum Speakers Presentations:

- 1) Main forum presentation time is limited to a maximum of 25 minutes with an additional 3-5 minutes allowed for Q&A (question and answer).
- 2) Sub-forum presentation time is limited to a maximum of 15 minutes, with an additional 3-5 minutes for Q&A.
- 3) Forum presentations must use pre-recorded video, but the Q&A period will be live communication.
- 3. Requirements for the Taiji Masters Demonstration:

The Taiji Masters demonstration may show various styles, techniques, and schools by use of a pre-recorded demonstration video or PPT presentation. The time limit is 10-15 minutes, with an additional 3-5 minutes for Q&A.

IV. Review of Papers and Performance

- 1. The contents of essays and videos must be legitimate and free from any intellectual property disputes. All responsibility for copyrights and permissions shall be borne by the contributor or applicant.
- 2. The organizing committee will invite a panel of experts to act as a review committee for the purpose of selecting presentations. The review committee will also recommend the best original unpublished papers for publication in the Journal of Taiji Science (JTS).
- 3. After the submission is approved, and unless the applicants have requested otherwise prior to the submission deadline, applicants are deemed to have authorized the organizing committee to use the author's photos, videos, and essay excerpts for publicity and promotional activities.

V. Awards

The forum is divided into mine theme forums; sub-forums; master and doctoral sessions and Taiji exhibition sessions

- 1. Excellent Paper Award
 - 1) The top 18 paper authors will be invited as Keynote speaker to the forum.
 - 2) 19 paper authors will be invited as speaker to the sub-forum; 25 paper author will be invited as speaker to the master and doctoral sessions.
 - 3) There are 10 excellent paper awards, will be awarded by the Organization committee.



- 4) Papers can be published in the JTS, mast recommended by the JTS review committee.
- 2. Masters Exhibition Awards
 - 1) 10 "Outstanding performance award", a digital certificate will be issued.
 - 2) 16 "Performance award", a digital certificate also will be issued.
- 3. The winners will be officially announced by the organizing committee and publicized through the WTSF, JTS, and public media.

 - 1) Submissions may be made in English or Chinese
 - 2) Submitting materials: According to the registration form below, fill in the title, abstract, first author's short bio, and provide a passport style photo (JPG format or PDF format). send the full text and PPT file by email.
- 2. Masters Exhibition Submissions.

Submitting materials: According to the registration form below. Masters' short bio, Introduction to the title of the exhibition, video or PPT files, 1 photo passport style photo, and 2 action photos (in JPG format or PDF format).
